If you feel like you are stretching yourself to give something to both of these worthy charities, then that is exactly what we are supposed to feel as we offer our almsgiving. Just as we fast from something during Lent and feel some discomfort, so too with our almsgiving, we offer something for the poor, and we are called to feel it sacrificially by going over and above whatever our usual giving to the poor may be. With both of these collections you can simply write out a check to Guardian Angels or St. Nicholas and we will then send it forward from here, and yes, all of your giving is tax deductible. I hope that you are all having a fruitful and meaningful Lenten journey. You are all always in my prayers.
