That way we can schedule a time for our ministers to visit and bring the Sacrament.

Financial Corner

In today's readings, both Isaiah and Peter hear the call of God and feel themselves unworthy. But, reassured by the Lord, both answer and follow. Do I hear the Lord asking, "Whom shall I send?" Am I prepared to answer, "Here I am. Send me!"?



A lot of Fish and a lot of Mercy

Place yourself in Peter's shoes for a moment. Jesus is with him in the boat teaching the crowds on shore. Who is this Jesus, he might have asked to himself. Then Jesus says to him, "Put out into deep water and lower your nets for a catch." Peter had considerable doubt that it would do any good, since they had caught nothing all night long. But he had some amount of trust in this great teacher even at that point. We can imagine his heart racing from the effort and emotion, gasping for breath as he made his way through the fish to where Jesus was sitting in the stern. He was approaching Jesus and perhaps this seemed unbearable because they were so different. Yet it probably seemed to him that Jesus' presence was an absolute gift to him.

He realized his unworthiness before him in being petty, false, angry, greedy, proud or vile, but now all of this had become a nauseating heap. Imagine barely being able to raise your eyes to Jesus, kneeling before him and saying, "Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man." How often have we shied away from getting really close to him because we feel this way? But he called him "Lord". And we can imagine how as these words dissipated and the moment passed that he understood that these words too were false.

When we come close to him, we recognize the truth of his mercy about ourselves and that he wants us to be forgiven so that we can follow him and live in him. "Do not be afraid: from now on you will be catching men." Are we ready to leave everything in order to follow these words? Peter and the others found them compelling enough to leave everything and follow him when they brought their boats to shore. Let us place our lives before His loving, merciful healing presence. Let us allow ourselves to hear these words most especially in the Sacrament of Reconciliation and to let them ring in our hearts in our prayers.



Mucho Pescado y mucha Misericordia

Ponte en los zapatos de Peter por un momento. Jesús está con él en la barca enseñando a la multitud en la orilla. ¿Quién es este Jesús?, podría haberse preguntado. Entonces Jesús le dice: “Rema mar adentro y echa las redes para pescar”. Peter tenía muchas dudas de que sirviera de algo, ya que no habían pescado nada en toda la noche. Pero tenía cierta confianza en este gran maestro incluso en ese momento. Podemos imaginar su corazón acelerado por el esfuerzo y la emoción, jadeando mientras se abría paso a través del pez hacia donde Jesús estaba sentado en la popa. Se acercaba a Jesús y tal vez esto le parecía insoportable porque eran muy diferentes. Sin embargo, probablemente le pareció que la presencia de Jesús era un regalo absoluto para él.

Se dio cuenta de su indignidad ante él por ser mezquino, falso, enojado, codicioso, orgulloso o vil, pero ahora todo esto se había convertido en un montón nauseabundo. Imagina apenas poder levantar la mirada hacia Jesús, arrodillándote ante él y diciéndole: “Apártate de mí, Señor, que soy un hombre pecador”. ¿Cuántas veces nos hemos negado a acercarnos realmente a él porque nos sentimos así? Pero él lo llamó “Señor”. Y podemos imaginar cómo a medida que estas palabras se disiparon y pasó el momento en que comprendió que estas palabras también eran falsas.

Cuando nos acercamos a él, reconocemos la verdad de su misericordia sobre nosotros mismos y que quiere que seamos perdonados para que podamos seguirlo y vivir en él. “No temas: de ahora en adelante serás pescador de hombres”. ¿Estamos dispuestos a dejarlo todo para seguir estas palabras? Peter y los demás los encontraron lo suficientemente convincentes como para dejarlo todo y seguirlo cuando trajeron sus botes a la orilla. Pongamos nuestras vidas ante Su amorosa y misericordiosa presencia sanadora. Dejémonos escuchar estas palabras muy especialmente en el Sacramento de la Reconciliación y dejémoslas resonar en nuestro corazón en nuestras oraciones.

TEOFANÍAS

Las lecturas de hoy relatan tres teofanías, o manifestaciones de la presencia de Dios. El profeta Isaías se ve atrapado en una escena dramática de adoración celestial, con un trono real, brasas ardientes y serafines que cantan, “Santo, santo, santo”. Isaías está sobrecogido. En el salmo responsorial, la asamblea añade su propia adoración a la de los serafines: “A la vista de los ángeles, cantaré tus alabanzas, Señor” (Salmo 138:1). Pablo recuerda a los corintios su propia experiencia de una aparición del Señor después de la resurrección, lo que lo hace un apóstol, pero “nacido de forma poco común” (1 corintios 15:8), ya que no conoció a Jesús de carne y hueso. Los primeros que sí conocieron a Jesús de carne y hueso se sorprendieron por los consejos de cómo pescar que les dio el maestro que había solicitado subir a la barca de Simón, y como consecuencia obtuvieron una pesca extraordinaria.
