The Mercy and Love of God

At first thought, our gospel seems impossible. Turning the other cheek, loving our enemies and doing good to those who hate us seems far too much. Who has the strength for that? How can we function in life if we never defend ourselves? What if the state were governed by the words of Jesus? Wouldn't crime and injustice have free reign?

Of course, the sayings of Jesus in our gospel today are not concerned with the state. The state has to punish crimes appropriately. But this is talking about me and my personal attitude and approach. It is talking about the question so decisive in my life. It is the question of whether or not I really love my neighbor.

What Jesus is asking of us can actually be summarized by the Golden Rule: "Do unto others as you would like them to do to you." If I am angry and worked up and rebuke someone and now find that the person concerned does not strike back, I am amazed and my anger evaporates. The friendliness of the person attacked disarms me. Through their "turning the other cheek", the spiral of violence has been interrupted. What happens if this does not take place? On an international scale we see the cycle of revenge that keeps on repeating itself between certain countries.

Yet Jesus goes on to teach, not just to refrain from striking back, but refers to the root from which this approach springs. The root is love. This is a disinterested love that comes not with any agenda, but only from generosity. It is marked by mercy, which always has its origin in God who sent his Son, Jesus to die for our sins. In showing each other mercy, we find life and resurrection. So we don't look upon the evil that people have done so much as that they are still human person's whom God loves. We would want to be looked upon this way, as children of God despite our mistakes.

We remember them in our prayers, and we wish to include them in our Holy Communion. Members of our community bring the Blessed Sacrament to them to comfort them and to unite us in the Eucharist. 

La Misericordia y el Amor de Dios

A primera vista, nuestro evangelio parece imposible. Poner la otra mejilla, amar a nuestros enemigos y hacer el bien a quienes nos odian parece demasiado. ¿Quién tiene la fuerza para eso? ¿Cómo podemos funcionar en la vida si nunca nos defendemos? ¿Qué pasaría si el estado fuera gobernado por las palabras de Jesús? ¿No tendrían reinado libre el crimen y la injusticia? Por supuesto, los dichos de Jesús en nuestro evangelio de hoy no tienen que ver con el estado. El Estado tiene que castigar los delitos adecuadamente. Pero esto está hablando de mí y de mi actitud y enfoque personal. Es hablar de la cuestión tan decisiva en mi vida. Es la cuestión de si realmente amo o no a mi prójimo. Lo que Jesús nos pide puede resumirse en la Regla de Oro: "Haz con los demás lo que te gustaría que hicieran contigo". Si estoy enojado y alterado y reprendo a alguien y ahora descubro que la persona en cuestión no me devuelve el golpe, me asombro y mi ira se evapora. La amabilidad de la persona agredida me desarma. Al "poner la otra mejilla", se ha interrumpido la espiral de violencia. ¿Qué pasa si esto no se lleva a cabo? A escala internacional vemos el ciclo de venganza que sigue repitiéndose entre ciertos países. Sin embargo, Jesús continúa enseñando, no solo a abstenerse de devolver el golpe, sino que se refiere a la raíz de la que brota este enfoque. La raíz es el amor. Este es un amor desinteresado que no viene con ninguna agenda, sino solo con generosidad. Está marcada por la misericordia, que siempre tiene su origen en Dios que envió a su Hijo Jesús a morir por nuestros pecados. Al mostrarnos misericordia unos a otros, encontramos vida y resurrección. Entonces, no miramos tanto el mal que la gente ha hecho como que todavía son personas humanas a quienes Dios ama. Quisiéramos ser mirados así, como hijos de Dios a pesar de nuestros errores.
