Communion for the Homebound: When we come together to pray at our Eucharistic liturgy, we do not forget the members of our community who are unable to be with us because of ill health. We remember them in our prayers, and we wish to include them in our Holy Communion. Members of our community bring the Blessed Sacrament to them to comfort them and to unite us in the Eucharist. We are not always aware of those who have this need. Please call the Parish Office to let us know if you or a member of your family would like to have Holy Communion brought to them. That way we can schedule a time for our ministers to visit and bring the Sacrament.

Hospital, Nursing Home, Homebound Visits: Churches are no longer notified by hospitals or nursing homes when a parishioner is admitted unless the family has requested it. If you or a family member are homebound, hospitalized or in a nursing home and would like a visit from a member of the ministry staff, please call the Parish Office.

SERVING GOD, NOT MAMMON

Jesus says, "You cannot serve God and mammon." Literally translated, "serve" means "be the slave of." The rich man believes that money sets him free, but in reality, it dominates him. Jesus is addressing something that has often been observed: money rules the world. "How much does it make?" "How can profits be increased?" "How can share prices be raised?" Those are the questions that dominate the world. And it seems that politics, as much as we hear and would like to hear otherwise, is driven by these concerns.

Yet, in our ordinary lives, we do have the concern of putting food on the table, of helping pay for our son's or daughter's education, being able to take a modest vacation. Do we have any free choice about finding a different lord besides mammon? Who can escape from the dominance of money? Jesus does indeed challenge us in a decided fashion to set ourselves free from slavery to the god mammon. And there is only one way to do that, as he tells us unequivocally: Become a servant of God! Only then will you be free. He is the only lord who will not reduce you to slavery. If you serve him, then you are neither the slave of money nor the slave of your own passions.

But how can I really do this? How can I get out of the slavery to money? Jesus tells an astonishing parable. He points out how clever are the "sons of this world" in making friends with money. Do as they do in being generous as a servant of God. Whenever you have more than you absolutely need, then be generous. Be ready to help, and think of those who are in need. Money may rule the world, yet there is the world power of loving your neighbor. Worldwide, there is an infinite amount of good being done, daily and hourly. And this power of goodness is a major source of hope for all those who are unwilling sufferers beneath the servitude of mammon. As long as this power exists, the world is not lost.

SIRVIENDO A DIOS, NO A MAMMON

Jesús dice: "No podéis servir a Dios y a las riquezas". Traducido literalmente, "servir" significa "ser esclavo de". El rico cree que el dinero lo libera, pero en realidad lo domina. Jesús se está refiriendo a algo que se ha observado a menudo: el dinero gobierna el mundo. "¿Cuánto gana?" "¿Cómo se pueden aumentar las ganancias?" "¿Cómo pueden subir los precios de las acciones?" Esas son las preguntas que dominan el mundo. Y parece que la política, por mucho que escuchemos y nos gustaría escuchar de otra manera, está impulsada por estas preocupaciones. Sin embargo, en nuestra vida ordinaria, sí tenemos la preocupación de poner comida en la mesa, de ayudar a pagar la educación de nuestro hijo o hija, de poder tomar unas vacaciones modestas. ¿Tenemos alguna opción libre de encontrar un señor diferente además de mamón? ¿Quién puede escapar del dominio del dinero? En efecto, Jesús nos desafía de manera decidida a liberarnos de la esclavitud del dios mamón. Y solo hay una manera de hacerlo, como nos dice inequívocamente: ¡Conviértete en un siervo de Dios! Sólo entonces serás libre. Él es el único señor que no os reducirá a la esclavitud. Si le sirves, no eres ni esclavo del dinero ni esclavo de tus propias pasiones. Pero, ¿cómo puedo realmente hacer esto? ¿Cómo puedo salir de la esclavitud del dinero? Jesús cuenta una parábola asombrosa. Señala cuán hábiles son los "hijos de este mundo" para hacerse amigos del dinero. Haz como ellos siendo generosos como siervos de Dios. Siempre que tengas más de lo que absolutamente necesitas, sé generoso. Esté listo para ayudar y piense en aquellos que están en necesidad. El dinero puede gobernar el mundo, pero existe el poder mundial de amar a tu prójimo. En todo el mundo, se está haciendo una cantidad infinita de bien, a diario y cada hora. Y este poder de la bondad es una fuente importante de esperanza para todos aquellos que sufren involuntariamente bajo la servidumbre de mamón. Mientras exista este poder, el mundo no está perdido.


