Communion for the Homebound: When we come together to pray at our Eucharistic liturgy, we do not forget the members of our community who are unable to be with us because of ill health. We remember them in our prayers, and we wish to include them in our Holy Communion. Members of our community bring the Blessed Sacrament to them to comfort them and to unite us in the Eucharist. We are not always aware of those who have this need. Please call the Parish Office to let us know if you or a member of your family would like to have Holy Communion brought to them. That way we can schedule a time for our ministers to visit and bring the Sacrament.

Hospital, Nursing Home, Homebound Visits: Churches are no longer notified by hospitals or nursing homes when a parishioner is admitted unless the family has requested it. If you or a family member are homebound, hospitalized or in a nursing home and would like a visit from a member of the ministry staff, please call the Parish Office.

WHO ARE THE ANGELS?

On this feast day of the Guardian Angels, you may be wondering who angels are and if they really exist. Sacred Scripture and the unanimity of Tradition definitely confirm their existence as spiritual beings without a body (non-corporeal). Saint Augustine says that the name “angel” speaks to their office or what they do and “spirit” speaks to what they are. With their whole beings, angels are servants and messengers of God. Angels always behold the face of their Father in heaven. They are the “mighty ones who do his word, hearkening to the voice of his word.” (Psalm 103:20). As purely spiritual creatures angels have intelligence and will. They are personal and immortal, surpassing in perfection all visible creatures, as the splendor of their glory bears witness (CCC 330).

One important thing to know about the angels is that Christ is the center of the angelic world. They are his angels: “...for in him all things were created in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible...” (Colossians 1:16). The life of Jesus, the Word incarnate is surrounded by the adoration and service of angels. In this service, he has made them messengers of his saving plan for the sake of those who are to obtain salvation (see Hebrews 1:14).

The archangels have a special role in the saving plan of God. The meaning of the archangel Gabriel’s name is “God is My Strength”. The angel Gabriel delivers special messages to Daniel to explain his visions and appears to Zechariah and the Blessed Virgin Mary to foretell the births of John the Baptist and Jesus, respectively. The angel Raphael, whose name means “God Has Healed”, appears to Tobit and acts as a physician to use a fish to heal Tobit’s eyes. The angel Michael, whose name means “Who is Like God?”, appears explicitly in the Book of Revelation (12: 7-12) where he does battle with Satan. The Prayer to Saint Michael which we say after every Mass, asks that we the faithful may be defended by Him. From 1886 – 1964, this prayer was recited after every low Mass.

Our catechism tells us that from infancy to death human life is surrounded by the angels’ watchful care and intercession. “Beside each believer stands an angel as protector and shepherd leading him [or her] to life.” We who are believers share by faith in their blessed company along with those united to God (CCC 336). May we always remember to pray for their protection and intercession each day.

¿QUIENES SON LOS ANGELES?

En esta fiesta de los Ángeles Guardianes, quizás te estés preguntando quiénes son los ángeles y si realmente existen. La Sagrada Escritura y la unanimidad de la Tradición confirman definitivamente su existencia como seres espirituales sin cuerpo (no corpóreos). San Agustín dice que el nombre “ángel” habla de su oficio o lo que hacen y “espíritu” habla de lo que son. Con todo su ser, los ángeles son servidores y mensajeros de Dios. Los ángeles siempre contemplan el rostro de su Padre en el cielo. Son los “poderosos que hacen su palabra, escuchando la voz de su palabra”. (Salmo 103:20). Como criaturas puramente espirituales, los ángeles tienen inteligencia y voluntad. Son personales e inmortales, superando en perfección a todas las criaturas visibles, como lo atestigua el esplendor de su gloria (CCC 330). Una cosa importante que debe saber acerca de los ángeles es que Cristo es el centro del mundo angélico. Son sus ángeles: “...porque en él fueron creadas todas las cosas en el cielo y en la tierra, visibles e invisibles...” (Colosenses 1:16). La vida de Jesús, el Verbo encarnado, está rodeada de adoración y servicio de los ángeles. En este servicio, los ha hecho mensajeros de su plan salvífico para los que han de alcanzar la salvación (cf. Hebreos 1,14). Los arcángeles tienen un papel especial en el plan salvífico de Dios. El significado del nombre del arcángel Gabriel es “Dios es mi fortaleza”. El ángel Gabriel entrega mensajes especiales a Daniel para explicarle sus visiones y se aparece a Zacarías ya la Santísima Virgen María para vaticinar los nacimientos de Juan el Bautista y Jesús, respectivamente. El ángel Rafael, cuyo nombre significa “Dios ha sanado”, se le aparece a Tobías y actúa como médico para usar un pez para curar los ojos de Tobías. El ángel Miguel, cuyo nombre significa “¿Quién como Dios?”, aparece explícitamente en el Libro del Apocalipsis (12:7-12) donde lucha contra Satanás. La Oración a San Miguel que decimos después de cada Misa, pide que los fieles seamos defendidos por Él. Desde 1886 hasta 1964, esta oración se rezaba después de cada Misa rezada. Nuestro catecismo nos dice que desde la infancia hasta la muerte la vida humana está rodeada por el cuidado vigilante y la intercesión de los ángeles. “Al lado de cada creyente se encuentra un ángel como protector y pastor que lo conduce a la vida”. Los creyentes compartimos por la fe su bendita compañía con los que están unidos a Dios (CIC 336). Que siempre recordemos orar por su protección e intercesión cada día.


