**Anointing:** If you wish to receive an anointing please call the Parish Office: (952) 227-4000.

**Communion for the Homebound:** When we come together to pray at our Eucharistic liturgy, we do not forget the members of our community who are unable to be with us because of ill health. We remember them in our prayers, and we wish to include them in our Holy Communion. Members of our community bring the Blessed Sacrament to them to comfort them and to unite us in the Eucharist. We are not always aware of those who have this need. Please call the Parish Office to let us know if you or a member of your family would like to have Holy Communion brought to them. That way we can schedule a time for our ministers to visit and bring the Sacrament.

**Hospital, Nursing Home, Homebound Visits:** Churches are no longer notified by hospitals or nursing homes when a parishioner is admitted unless the family has requested it. If you or a family member are homebound, hospitalized or in a nursing home and would like a visit from a member of the ministry staff, please call the Parish Office.

## GOD IS MAKING SOMETHING NEW

In our gospel, Jesus speaks of false prophets, destruction, suffering, and persecution in the end times. He speaks even about the destruction of the Temple that stood for many centuries in all of its splendor. Jesus prunes away every loyalty that is too external. Should this give us an apocalyptic, end-of-the-world feeling? This is not Jesus' attitude. We cannot be careless, but we cannot get into a panic about the end of the world either.

The news outlets seem to know what preoccupies people and what people find interesting. It seems that whenever we watch the news, we hear a great deal about politics, war and unrest, and the economy. These seem to be the big three in our time.

In Jesus' time, the big three were religion, politics, and nature. But the resurrection of Jesus has shook and rearranged the thinking in all of these areas. The only thing that is truly enduring, absolute, and central around which everything else revolves is the resurrection. The apocalyptic way in which Jesus speaks in Luke's gospel "unveils" this truth for us. So what are we to do? What are we to do when we hear of many calamities politically and economically, both here and abroad? We are a people of the resurrection. Work quietly to build up the Church, the mystical body of Christ, the sign of Christ here on Earth, of which you are a member. Work quietly to understand Catholic social teaching, not in an excessively preoccupied way, but as a responsible citizen. Work to spread the ultimate news, the only news that is foundational and absolute—the resurrection. Do it by making your offering of what you have been given. Do it in gratitude, not fear, as we approach Thanksgiving, the day of gratitude.

## DIOS ESTÁ HACIENDO ALGO NUEVO

En nuestro evangelio, Jesús habla de falsos profetas, destrucción, sufrimiento y persecución en los últimos tiempos. Habla incluso de la destrucción del Templo que se mantuvo durante muchos siglos en todo su esplendor. Jesús poda toda lealtad demasiado externa. ¿Debería esto darnos una sensación apocalíptica del fin del mundo? Esta no es la actitud de Jesús. No podemos ser descuidados, pero tampoco podemos entrar en pánico por el fin del mundo. Los medios de comunicación vistos para saber qué preocupa a la gente y qué le interesa a la gente. Parece que cada vez que vemos las noticias, escuchamos mucho sobre política, guerra y disturbios, y la economía. Estos parecen ser los tres grandes de nuestro tiempo. En la época de Jesús, los tres grandes eran la religión, la política y la naturaleza. Pero la resurrección de Jesús ha sacudido y reorganizado el pensamiento en todas estas áreas. Lo único que es verdaderamente perdurable, absoluto y central alrededor del cual gira todo lo demás es la resurrección. La forma apocalíptica en que Jesús habla en el evangelio de Lucas "desvela" esta verdad para nosotros. Entonces, ¿qué vamos a hacer? ¿Qué debemos hacer cuando nos enteramos de muchas calamidades políticas y económicas, tanto aquí como en el extranjero? Somos un pueblo de la resurrección. Trabajad sosegadamente en la edificación de la Iglesia, cuerpo místico de Cristo, signo de Cristo aquí en la Tierra, de la que sois miembros. Trabajen en silencio para comprender la enseñanza social católica, no de manera excesivamente preocupada, sino como ciudadanos responsables. Trabajen para difundir la última noticia, la única noticia que es fundamental y absoluta: la resurrección. Hazlo haciendo tu ofrenda de lo que se te ha dado. Hágalo con gratitud, no con miedo, a medida que nos acercamos al Día de Acción de Gracias, el día de la gratitud.


