#### THE GIFT OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

We have a lot to learn from those who are seriously ill. Often, in spite of reasons for fear of difficulties such as loss of hair due to chemotherapy, and greater dependency on others that is a big change, loved ones often say of their loved one that he or she is placing all of his or her hope in God. It's a familiar story that we see countless times: those who are seriously ill have hope which leads them to experience peace. How does this happen? They have nothing to cling to—no freedom, no lack of pain, nothing in this world except the Triune God.

The apostle Philip was a great example of this. He had nothing to cling to in order to make the Samaritans believe, except the Holy Spirit within him. By the Holy Spirit, the gospel spread after the martyrdom of Stephen. And Philip lived by the Holy Spirit, trusting in Him as God's beloved disciple. 1 Peter 3:15 says, "Always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks you for a reason for your hope."

For Philip, this reason is not that all was well materially or even physically. Rather it was that he was open to the Holy Spirit and, thus, open to all that God would give him as he proclaimed the Gospel. For those seriously ill, they teach us this openness as well. Living this way attracts others because our horizon of hope is not limited, but based on what God can do. Even for those who are very sick, it opens possibilities for prayer, love, acceptance, forgiveness, and the beauty of God's love.

In Him we live and move and have our being. Let us pray that God will give us great reasons for hope!


