

One of the great privileges that I and the delegation of lay people from our Archdiocese had was to attend this year's Ordination for the Diocese of Kitui. This year seven men were ordained by the bishop, Bishop Joseph Mwongela, and that was the most they ever had. The seminary formation is impressive to me. It consists of nine years of preparation and study and in eight of those years, each seminarian was assigned to one parish per year to work there and gain experience.

I was so surprised when the bishop announced for certain members of the priestly body (those who had worked with them, etc.), including the guests from the Archdiocese of

Saint Paul and Minneapolis to come to lay hands on the heads of those ordained. "That's me!" I thought. What a great privilege! I feel a sense of brotherhood now not only with the newly ordained, but the other priests who hosted us and worked with us to show us around the various schools, marketplaces that benefited from our support with loans, and the water projects. The people are just like you and me, except with certain struggles. They live hope and do so with joy even as they cope with difficulty.

The ordination was about five to six hours long (they don't have Saturday evening Mass there), and two things stood out. One was that when each priest knelt before the bishop to pledge obedience, be anointed on the hands and forehead, and receive the paten and chalice, their response was spoken into a microphone, as opposed to simply having background music like we do. The people would cheer when each ordinant gave his promise of obedience to the bishop. The second was that, among the several speeches that took place after the Mass, the people came running down to the field to welcome their newly ordained priest to their parish. In a couple of cases, they carried them off the field like a winning football coach.

Come to my 20th anniversary celebration and I will have more pictures and experiences of Kitui to share. It is on the evening of Wednesday, July 12th.
