JOIN THE CATHOLIC ADVOCACY NETWORK AND HELP SAVE LIVES AND THE HEARTACHE OF ABORTION

I thank all parishioners for your support of our spring Baby Shower that our Respect Life Committee sponsored. It was heartening to see the baby items stack up in support of our local pregnancy resource center, Southwest Options for Women in Eden Prairie.

Meanwhile, during this past legislative session, Governor Walz and the Minnesota state legislature have passed and signed into law a number of disturbing anti-life, anti-woman, and anti-family measures. But because we know that Christ will always prevail, we must continue to speak out for the Gospel of Life and uphold its dignity and the common good in Minnesota!

During the last legislative session, many pro-life provisions, passed over several decades after much hard work by many, have been removed. Yet we cannot be deterred. Your voice, actions, prayers, and efforts to build relationships with your lawmakers all have a positive impact. This year 7,361 messages were sent to legislators through the Catholic Advocacy Network urging their opposition to pro-abortion measures. Because you spoke up for protecting young girls from the harms of abortion and for parental rights, you helped keep the parental notification law on the books!

Yet, there were many important, common-sense, pro-life measures that were repealed or lost. Here is a summary:

- **Women's Right to Know: Repealed.** Women seeking an abortion in Minnesota will no longer have the right to be provided information regarding their child's gestational age and developmental stage as they consider whether to have an abortion.
- **Informed consent: Repealed.** Women no longer have the right to be provided with medically accurate information on the abortion procedure before they consent.
- **Hospitalization law: Repealed.** An abortion in the second trimester and beyond no longer needs to be performed in a hospital where she could immediately receive the care needed to save her life when complications arise.
- **Physician's only law: Repealed.** No longer is it required that a physician perform an abortion.
- **The Born Alive Infant Protection Act: Gutted.** This act, which previously protected children who survived a botched abortion by requiring life-preserving care on par with a child born at the same gestational age, is now not only gutted, but is even dangerous for any infant born alive. The law now only requires "care" which was confirmed on the House floor to mean "comfort care" - a warm blanket and left to die. Most disturbingly though, removed from the law is the language specifying that the care is to be provided to an infant who survives an abortion, and instead refers to any infant. This places at greatest risk infants born with medical complications and/or disabilities. Our most vulnerable of the vulnerable!

I encourage you to [join the Catholic Advocacy Network at www.mncatholic.org](http://www.mncatholic.org). This is the legislative advocacy arm of the Minnesota Catholic Bishops. As a member you will be formed in the faith, informed on the issues, and provided the tools to transform our state into a place that truly upholds life, dignity, and the common good. Let's not be deterred. Let's take action and live the gospel of life!

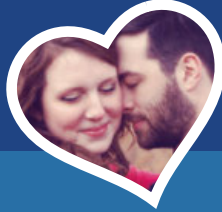
