

Dear Parishioners.

In addition to ongoing and steady Sunday contributions, gifts from estates are often given to the Church in memory of a loved one. Several other forms of life income gifts also exist as ways to make a planned charitable gift. One very popular method, utilized by several parishioners, is to roll over Required Minimum Distributions from IRA's directly to the parish, which avoids taxes on these distributions. Feel free to call Joel Swanson, our Business Administrator, as an initial source of information on this option.

Other examples of such life income gifts include charitable gift annuities, donor advised funds, and family endowment funds. These means of giving, in addition to regular giving, form an important financial part of a healthy parish. Often, they are given to support a maintenance or other special project.

The Catholic Community Foundation, which often helps members of parishes set up such personal estate and planned gifts, advocates writing a letter to children or loved ones that tell what you would want them to remember about your life, the wisdom you would want to pass on to them, and the values that you would want to leave them. Such a letter, accompanying an estate or planned gift, may be an effective way of communicating to them what you hold dear, including your involvement and worship at The Church of the Guardian Angels or the The Church of Saint Nicholas. We have more information in this season of Thanksgiving on the back desk or table at Guardian Angels and on the back ledge at Saint Nicholas.

May God grant us His blessings as we seek to serve Him and give Him great thanks!




