

THE DISCERNMENT TEAM IS WORKING

The Discernment Team is doing its work after we have conducted our Prayer and Listening Sessions. Thank you so much for attending them and prayerfully discussing the hopes that you have for our parish, the challenges and the things that we might need to let go of. We really appreciate the time commitment you made to participate in them. Although I did not sit at any of the tables, I thought that everyone expressed their heartfelt desires to see the parish grow in many constructive and varied ways. As of November 8th, the day that this article was due, we have not yet compiled the results of the written surveys. However, the Discernment Team, after team members

themselves attended the sessions, is hard at work as we begin to consider both what our parish statistics at Guardian Angels and at Saint Nicholas are telling us, and what our Archdiocese is envisioning for each parish in beginning Parish Evangelization Cell Systems, otherwise known as small groups.

On November 6th, we discussed Mass attendance and sacramental data and since 2013, there has been a dramatic decline in these numbers at both parishes. These trends are God's call to us to begin to do things differently! Please pray that the Holy Spirit will work through our process. Several months from now, the process will include a presentation to all parishioners of what we will propose to be important action steps toward changing this decline in the coming months and years.

Now, as our next step on November 20th, we will hear a presentation on the vision of small groups at our parishes and in early December we will review the results and summaries from the Prayer and Listening Sessions. We understand the skepticism of those who would say, "It's no use. Everything has already been decided." But we firmly believe that the Holy Spirit is in charge and will lead us. No decisions have been made.

May God bless all of the steps we take in faith in His guidance and call as we give Him thanks.

The Basilica of St. Mary, Minneapolis




