Many college students also find their way to our Cathedral or other parishes with young adult ministry that they discover to be vibrant in ways that they could not have anticipated. These are just some examples. Help your young adult son or daughter get connected!

Summer is also a time for vacations. Take a great vacation! To me, when I go to Mass with those with whom I am vacationing, it is a great part of the experience. Yes, there is a need to plan for it ahead of time, but that makes it part of the vacation plans. Sometimes, we are with those, even our own family members, who do not think it is that important. But when we assert that we need to go to Mass, we are being witnesses to Jesus Christ. It is okay to say that we need this to be a part of our experience. It really does make for a vacation that is balanced, wholesome, interesting, and something for which to be thankful to God when we return home after experiencing the universal Church at a faraway place. MassTimes.org is a great resource for Mass times in a local area as well as confession and Eucharistic Adoration. Whether you really have the opportunity for Eucharistic adoration or not, keep prayer and our Lord Jesus a priority wherever you go. I always love to see how the different Catholic churches in different areas do things. It is always a nice part of the vacation to visit another Catholic Church.

Dear Parishioners,

Thank you for your generous donation of \$1,072.00 to Bountiful Basket Food Shelf. Our mission is simple—To eliminate hunger for people in need of food. And, thanks to your generosity, we are able to provide just that—nourishment *and hope* to individuals and families facing food insecurity.

We see many hard-working families walk through our door—nurses, teachers, bus drivers, construction workers, etc., whose wages are not keeping up with the cost of living. According to the Census Bureau, the poverty rate rose to 12.4% in 2022 from 7.8% in 2021, the largest one-year jump on record. People are working hard yet not making ends meet.

The demand we are currently experiencing is something we have never experienced before. This past year, we have served 78% more households than last year. We distributed over 750,000 pounds of food, compared to 340,000 last year. This growth is in response to community demand for service stemming from housing costs, inflation, high food prices, and stagnant wages. Thanks to a supportive community, like you, we have been able to meet this demand.

Thank you again for your gift. Our success, and our community's stability, is predicated on the kindness of individuals like you.
