

## LIFELONG LEARNING OF OUR FAITH



Dear Parishioners,

On this Catechetical Sunday it is worth reflecting on how we never stop learning our faith. William Glasser, renowned psychiatrist once said, "We learn: 10% of what we read, 20% of what we hear, 30% of what we see, 50% of what we see and hear, 70% of what we discuss, 80% of what we experience, and 95% of what we teach to others." Would you like to grow in your faith? Maybe not all of us are comfortable being teachers for our faith formation.

Yet, there are so many roles that each of us can play to make our year an offering to God that glorifies Him. We have a need for assistants in the classroom, small group leaders for Wednesdays or for special events, hall monitors, those who could help us prepare food for special events, those who could help us with other special events such as our first sacrament retreats. The list goes on and on. Tell us how you could imagine yourself helping. Just let Viviana Sotro or me know, or just call the office.

Of course, we would welcome more teachers. One teacher described her experience this way: "I really enjoyed my group. They ask very good questions and this made me have to think and oftentimes do my own investigating and get back to them. Learning along with them was very beneficial to my growth in faith." For those who are thinking about this possibility of being a teacher, I say, pray about it and let the Holy Spirit guide you.

The document, "Our Hearts Were Burning Within Us," by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, 1999, goes as far to say,

In addition, adult faith formation should serve as the point of reference for catechesis for other age groups. It ought to be "the organizing principle, which gives coherence to the various catechetical programs offered by a particular Church." Maturity of faith is the intent of all catechesis from the earliest years. Thus, all catechesis is geared to a lifelong deepening of faith in Christ. How necessary, then, that the catechetical ministry with adults set an example of the highest quality and vitality. For such reasons as these, the Church wisely and repeatedly insists that adult faith formation is "essential to who we are and what we do as Church" and must be "situated not at the periphery of the Church's educational mission but at its center." (nos. 41-42).

For these reasons, I and Deacon John Cleveland invite you to our Encounter group. We meet on most Wednesdays from 6:30 to 7:45 PM beginning September 25<sup>th</sup>. We will focus on the new Symbolon series from the Augustine Institute on Formed.org.

Speaking of this website, we have a parish subscription and it has a wealth of Catholic programming from various children's series, to movies, to various adult series in many forms. Just go to Formed.org and click on "find your parish subscription." May our desire to learn our faith together as a community be a joyful witness to all!



## **BOUNTIFUL BASKET NEWS** UPDATE

In July, we celebrated the one-year anniversary of our Cologne location, and what an incredible year it has been! In our first month, we provided just 23 food services and just this past month we've seen that number soar to 232—an increase of over 1000%! While it's bittersweet to celebrate this growth, knowing it reflects ongoing community needs, we remain committed to serving the community with smiles, dignity, and healthy food.

We're excited to announce that we've recently relocated to a more central retail space in downtown Cologne, which offers expanded shopping and warehouse areas.

## **GUARDIAN ANGELS CEMETERY UPDATE**

FOOD SHELF

Sometime between Saturday, August 17th at 3:00 p.m. and Monday, August 19th at 10:00 a.m., our shed was broken into, and a Toro riding lawn mower was stolen from the cemetery. A police report was made and also a report to the insurance company. Originally, we paid \$8,000.00 for the mower. Now, after depreciation and deductible, we received \$5,000.00 from our insurance company, Catholic Mutual. The cost of a replacement mower is \$10,000.00. If anyone was at the cemetery and saw anything or anyone near the shed during the times and dates listed above, please call the Parish Office at 952-227-4000. Thank you to Jack Worm and his grandson for the work they have done recently to make it very difficult for someone to take anything in the future from this shed.

Other projects at the cemetery are two retaining walls that need repair. One is 72 feet long and 4 feet high. The other is 90 feet long and 3 feet high. Once these are repaired, we will then have to repair the road. These projects will be done in three phases and the estimated cost is about \$30,000.00.

The Cemetery Board would like to thank the Garage Sale Committee for their donation toward the repair of the walls.

We would like to thank Randy Worm for the donation of three loads of dirt to be used in spots needed along with new plots, as they needed it, too.


