THE HOLY FAMILY

“When they had finished everything required by the law of the Lord, they returned to Galilee, to their own town of Nazareth. The child grew and became strong, filled with wisdom; and the favor of God was upon him.”

- Luke 2:39-40

One place that I have always wanted to visit as a pilgrimage site is the Holy house of Loreto in central Italy. According to the guide to pilgrimage destinations published in 2000 by the Official Catholic Directory “scientific and archeological studies continue to affirm what the faithful have believed for centuries: that Jesus, Mary, and Joseph once lived in this home.” According to legend, in 1291 the Blessed Virgin Mary’s house was transported by angels from Nazareth to Croatia, and later, in 1294, to the hill of Loreto. Building materials used in the house correspond to those used in the “basement” of the home still in place at the Basilica of the Annunciation in Nazareth. Also, graffiti cuts in the stones match those found at Nazareth.

It is intriguing. In any case, whether we ever have a chance to see this house or not, we can place ourselves in our prayers in the home of the Holy Family and imagine what it would’ve been like. With the light of the world dwelling in the house, there would have been a great blend of human and the divine, the extraordinary found in the ordinary. We can imagine the extraordinary affection that they had for each other as they served each other in very ordinary ways. Mary would’ve taken care to prepare meals, mend clothes, and make the house attractive, but modest and a place fitting for God to dwell. Joseph would’ve had great humility as he taught carpentry to his son, Jesus, the Son of God. And Jesus would’ve grown in a house of intimate family warmth serving his mother and father by being a good son. For Mary the events of Jesus’ ordinary life at home would’ve been the joy of her soul.

We can think back to those loved ones in our lives who loved us with extraordinary affection through ordinary means. My grandmother of happy memory was one such person in my life. She always gave in ordinary ways, but it added up to extraordinary affection that helped shape my life.

The Holy Family teaches us that we can make holy the everyday things and events in our lives—the everyday work of looking after those closest to us, the work in which the whole family cooperates, and the humor that comes in the face of difficulties and misunderstandings. The Holy Family provides us with a model of family life where God is truly present in cheerfulness, in a spirit of affection for and service toward each other, and in a prayerful way of approaching life.

May God bless your family with holiness, love, and service toward one another in this holy season and beyond!
