

THE HOLY SPIRIT MATTERS TO US!



In Jesus' farewell discourse to his disciples at the Last Supper, I am struck by the ways in which he described the Holy Spirit who was to come. Jesus described the Holy Spirit as the Spirit of Consolation, the Spirit of Truth, and, in so many words, the Spirit of Unity. He said things such as "And I will ask the Father and He will give you another Advocate to be with you always, the Spirit of Truth..." (Jn 14: 16-17). In another moment, He even said to them, "But I tell you the truth, it is better for you that I go. For if I do not go, the Advocate will not come to you. But if I go, I will send Him to you" (Jn 16:7). The Holy Spirit's presence with

the Apostles and with the entire Church throughout the centuries is always meant to be a comfort, a consolation, a leader, and a guide to Jesus' friends.

If we think back to the Last Supper, the impending departure of Jesus was troubling to his friends. They didn't know what was about to happen and did not understand the many things that Jesus was saying. Jesus knew this, so he not only instituted the Holy Eucharist, whereby He would always be present to His friends, but he also promised them the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, who would dwell with them and make it possible for them to live for Him, just as He was asking them to do.

Now, we thank God for the Be My Witnesses Assembly that took place at Cretin-Derham Hall high school, as part of the continuation of implementing our Synod process in our archdiocese. We say, "Come, Holy Spirit" with Mary, Mother of the Church. Surely as she was present at Pentecost, she heard the promises of Jesus and kept these things in her heart with great hope in His promises. We can see in such an assembly, an echo of Mary and the Apostles gathering to call upon the Holy Spirit to come. The assembly was a time of discernment of how our local church can move forward in our time and place knowing that we have received the call of Jesus to go and "make disciples of all the nations."

I am quite sure that the archbishop will direct the sharing and reporting of what took place at the assembly and how the Holy Spirit directed it all. Already he writes,

"I came away so moved by the way that the Holy Spirit gently led the Assembly in their consideration of the eight propositions being considered, enabling them to coalesce on the importance of supporting discipleship in daily life, promoting welcome and hospitality in our parishes, and providing comprehensive faith formation, all with a real attentiveness to the particular needs of youth and young adults. The peace that characterized the discussions could only be attributed to the Holy Spirit and to Mary's intercession."

We will definitely focus on these priorities. In the meantime, rest awhile longer in the experience of Pentecost and listen to how the Holy Spirit is calling you to be a part of our renewal with the unique charisms that are God-given gifts that He has given you. We are one body with many parts and each have an essential role in the building up of our Church.

In the weeks and months to come, we will have an opportunity to participate in a Life in the Spirit seminar, School of Charism Discovery, or Called and Gifted workshop. May the Holy Spirit lovingly guide us all in our local church.



PEN PAL LETTER WRITING WITH PEOPLE JAILED BY ICE IN MN

Conversations with Friends (CWF) is the all-volunteer humanitarian organization dedicated to ending isolation whose members have been visiting and supporting people detained by ICE since 2011. We warmly and enthusiastically invite you (bilingual Spanish/English speakers, 22 years old and older) to attend our CWF Zoom training on Saturday, June 21st, 9 a.m.-1 p.m., in English, including multiple presenters; info about immigration law; profiles/ stories/audios of people with whom we have written and visited; CWF info; pen pal and visitor info; Q&A; multiple breaks; and more. After attending you can join us as a pen pal (amigo por correspondencia), writing weekly until they leave detention to a person jailed by ICE (Immigration and Customs Enforcement) in the Freeborn, Kandiyohi, or Sherburne County Jails here in Minnesota.

This is an opportunity to live the Gospel by accompanying our brothers and sisters in ICE detention who are suffering from isolation, uncertainty and/or trauma as they face likely deportation and separation from their families and friends. Through this ministry they come to know that we in the community truly care, they are not abandoned, not alone.


