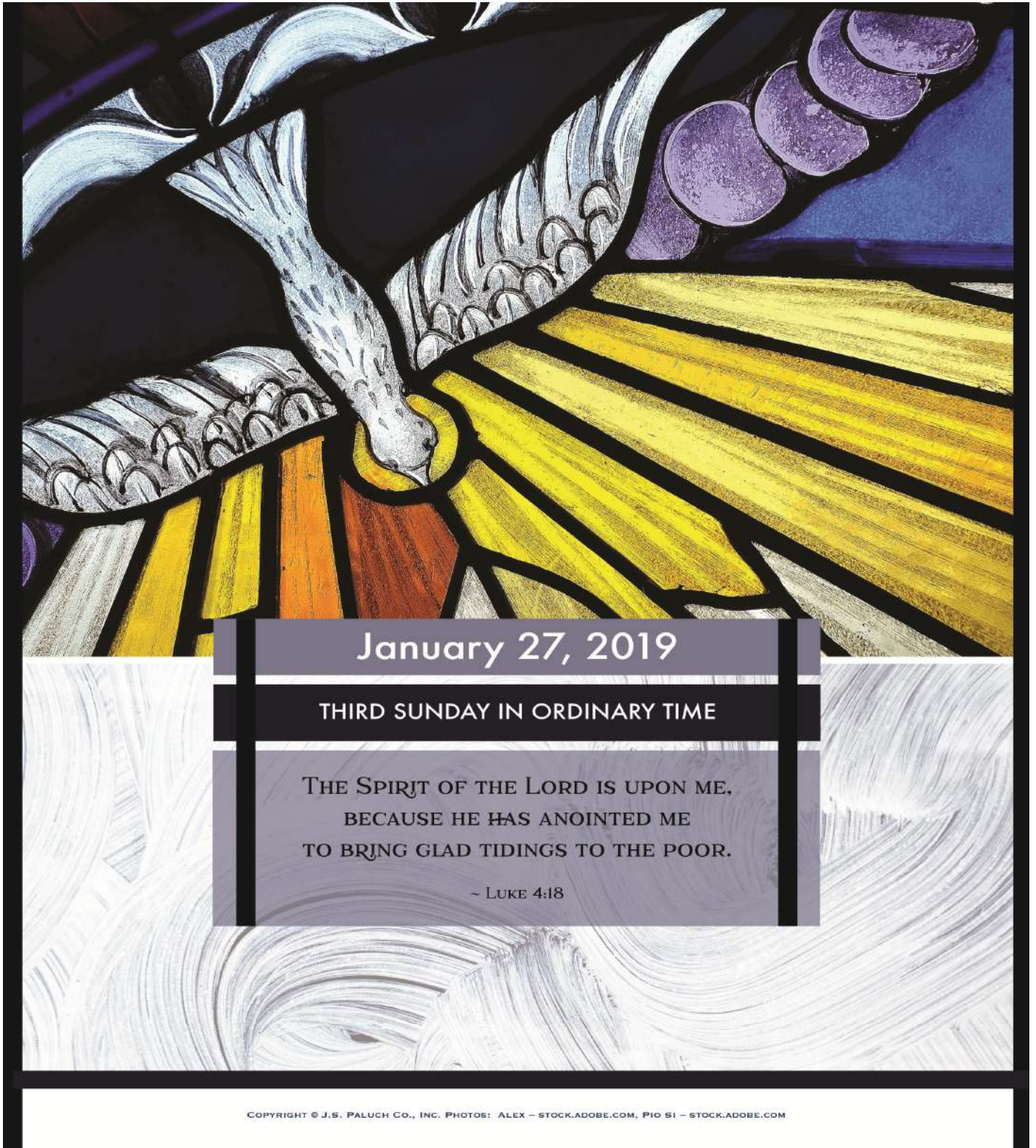

GA School Receives \$50,000 Matching Grant!

Just in time for our Catholic Schools Week, I'm happy to announce that our Guardian Angels School has received a \$50,000 matching grant from the Catholic Schools Center of Excellence (CSCOE). If we can raise \$50,000, we'll receive this grant. The CSCOE part of the grant will go for things such as our music program, STEM program, technology, updating classrooms, staff development and more. The matching funds that we raise can be used for any needs at the school such as tuition assistance, operating expenses, equipment, maintenance, etc. A bonus is that a generous donor has already stepped forward to offer \$5,000 for the match, so now all that we need to raise is \$45,000 to meet the match! We have a deadline of May 31, but it would be great to succeed much sooner since we will not receive the grant until we have raised the full \$50,000. Donations from any and all are accepted! 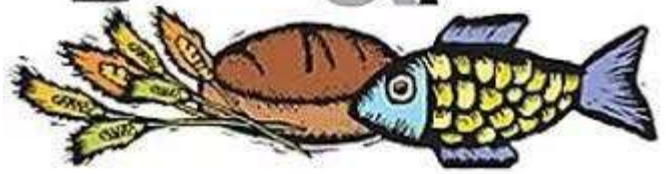

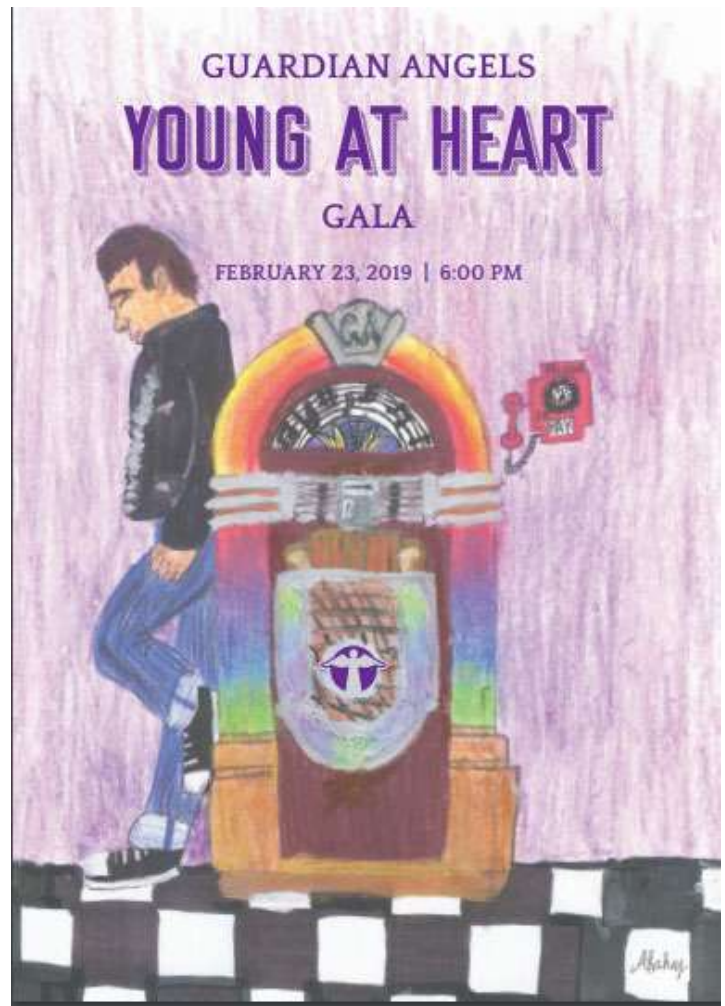
